

Hunleth Music Company

St Louis, Missouri

- 1874 Frank J. Hunleth starts Standard Pulley & Foundry.
- 1901 Frank sells his shares in Standard to start Hunleth Music at 9 South Broadway in St Louis.
- 1908 Frank's sons Joseph and Alois take over management.
- 1915 Huleth Music moves to 516 Locust St. Joseph makes a trip to Europe to buy instruments and music.
- 1952 Huleth Music moves to 415 North Broadway.
- 1959 Alois dies, leaving the store to Joseph.
- 1963 Hunleth Music Co incorporates on August 27 (opencorporates.com).
- 1968 Joseph dies, leaving the store to his widow Violet.
- 1974 The store closes and the company is dissolved on September 4 (opencorporates.com).
