- 1903 Frank W. Anglund is born on November 24 in Kansas City.
- 1920 Frank is living with his parents in Wyandotte, Kansas (census).
- 1930 Frank is living at 1005 Isabella in Houston, Texas, and playing the trumpet for a radio orchestra (census).
- 1935 Frank is living at 814 Sunnyside Ave in Chicago (census).
- 1936 Frank marries Margaret (b. 1916 in FL) in Chicago. He starts making trumpet mouthpieces at this time and becomes a dealer for trumpets made by Elden Benge (Joe Lill).
- 1940 Frank is playing lead trumpet for the Chicago Theater and living at 814 Sunnyside Ave (census). He joins the Santy Runyan School of Music (*International Musician*, March).
- 1946 Frank switched from the theater to the NBC orchestra in Chicago (Lill).
- 1947 Frank is teaching at the Metropolitan School of Music (*International Musician*, Dec 31).
- 1948 Frank is running ads for his own studio at 509 S. Wabash in Chicago (below, *International Musician*, 1948-49).

- 1952 Frank is teaching at the Knapp School of Percussion, 509 S. Wabash, Chicago (top photo, *Int. Musician*, Sept.).
- 1955 Frank and his family move to West Palm Beach, Florida (obit.).
- 1960 Frank Anglund dies on October 28 from a stroke. At the time, he owned a hardware store (obituary in Kansas City Star). He is buried in Kansas City.
