1881 starts in March (probably on r, 2<sup>nd</sup> photo)

1906 resigns as agent in October

1904-1906 J. L. Taylor?

1906-1922 William M. Clear (1868-1961)

1886-1902 telegrapher & assistant agent at Hadley

1902 starts as agent in Riverside in September

1906 transfers to Hadley station after Griffing resigns

1922 transferred to Salem, NY station in January

1924 transferred to Westport, NY station

1927-1941 station agent at Ausable Forks

1907-c.1927 **James F. Kelly** 

1907 takes over Cotes position as telegrapher

1922 appointed station agent starting January 3rd

1927 moves to Essex County in April

1910-1928 Renwick J. Fisher (1865-1933)

1910 starts as baggage master in May at Hadley

1928 resigns job in June; baggage master & freight agent

1926 Henry Murphy

1926 mentioned as station agent in September

1927-1928 **Edward Dupree** (1893-?)

1927 station agent at Hadley replacing Kelly

1928 returns to agent job at Merriam in November

1928 Francis Stanton

1928 replaces Fisher in June; gone in 1929

1928-1942 Charles E. Hughes (1891-1949)

1917 station agent & telegrapher at South Corinth

1920 same

1928 replaces Dupree as station agent

1942 transfers to Lake George station

1943-? **James F. Lynch** (1895-?)

1930-1940 railroad fireman in Mechanicville

1943 listed as station & freight agent in Hadley

1951 a J.F. Lynch is listed as station agent in January
