## **Thurman Station Agents**

1870 - 1933

1878-1881 **Edward T. Griffin** (1848-?)

1878 listed as station agent

1881 ends in March; transfers to Hadley

1881-1907 **Stephen B. Griffing** (1830-?)

1881 starts as station agent in March

1892 station & express agent

1906 Charley Elwell temporary agent during illness

1907 transferred to new freight office in Warr. in April

c.1907-1917 **Sheridan Herbert Spencer** (1873-?)

c.1895 starts working for D&H

1907 may have started as agent in Thurman

1909 station agent; marries Carrie

1910 station agent; paid \$50/month

1913 agent at Thurman

1917 living in Thurman; possibly still agent

1920 in Rutland, VT

1926 transferred from Albany to freight office in H. Falls

1928 ticket agent & telegrapher for more than 30 years

and is moving to the Glens Falls office as a clerk

1918-1920 **Lester James Love** (1889-c.1962)

1914 telegrapher in Ft. Ann

1918 starts as Thurman station agent on May 9<sup>th</sup>

1920 starts at Railway Express in Warr. in July

1920-1953 Railway Express agent in Warrensburg

c.1920-1923 J. A. Cullinan

1922 station agent at Thurman until April, 1923

1923 H. S. Wells

1923 station agent at Thurman

1926 Floyd West

1926 mentioned as agent in July

192?-1931 **Hugh O. Jones** (1899-1985)

1930 census listing as Station Agent (probably Thurman)

1932 transfers to The Glen with the closing of Thurman

station January 1st; at Thurman "a number of years"

1932 listed as Station & Freight Agent for The Glen

1934 probably agent until station closes

1940 Telegraph operator for D&H in Westport, NY

1985 died in Essex County

1932-1933 station agent is only part time in summer months

1933 station closes and is replaced by a passenger shelter

c.1953 the passenger shelter is removed
