- 1918 William Peate of Peate's Music House, Utica, and Robert White of Cleveland have formed Peate & White in Utica and have purchased the entire stock of musical merchandise from the Charles Williams Stores, Inc., Brooklyn for \$50,000 (Music Trade Review, June).
- 1928 Charles Williams Stores is purchased by National Bellas Hess.
